

# SHENANDOAH'S ALL-STAR STAINED GLASS TEAM

**DR. GARY M. GRAY, PRESIDENT**, has been in the church management field since 1967 when he attended his first NACBA conference. He was Minister of Administration, and then served as the primary trainer for church administrators (1973-1980) through his firm, the *National Institute on Church Management*. He moved in 1980 to New York City to be the National Sales Executive for *The Genesis Project*, the company filming the Bible word-for-word.

In late 1983 he joined Shenandoah and rose to the position of Chief Strategic Officer. He served as a consultant for stained glass projects in 46 states. In 1996 he left to go into the Christian publishing business and was publisher and editor of *Christian Cruise* and *Living Solo* magazines holding contracts with *Carnival*, *Royal Caribbean*, *Princess*, *Holland America*, *Celebrity*, and *Norwegian* cruise lines. Because his magazines were travel related, however, he was not able to survive the impact of the 9/11 disaster. This gave us the unique opportunity to bring Dr. Gray back to Shenandoah as our President in 2002.

Dr. Gray holds graduate degrees from Phillips, Oklahoma State, Southern Methodist, and Notre Dame. In 1996 he was elected to the Church Management Hall of Fame and is the author of ten books. An avid student of the American President, he does historical portrayals (Washington, Jefferson, A. Johnson, Garfield, T. Roosevelt, and FDR) as president of *Mr. Presidents.com*.
